Radmila Iva Janković is a historian of art and comparative literature.

From 2000 to 2007, she was a curator at the Gallery of Extended Media, and since 2008 she has been a curator at the Zagreb Museum of Contemporary Art, where she manages the *Atelijer Kožarić* collection.

She is the author of numerous texts on contemporary art that she published in culture and art magazines and exhibition catalogs, and the editor of numerous publications. To date, she has organized over 80 exhibitions, among which we highlight retrospectives dedicated to the artists of the Gorgona circle: *Miljenko Horvat: Searches* (2012), *Julije Knifer: Uncompromising* (2014); *Ivan Kožarić: One of the possible 100* (2021).

She is the winner of the HS AICA annual award for 2012.
